NEUROCOGNITIVE UPDATES

This Special Broadcast is being sent after our Data Management group indicated that they have found several errors in the **Trail Making Tests (TMT), Part A and Part B** for studies **WF 98213, WF 97116 and WF 97415**. We would like to clarify a couple points about administration of the TMT and how to score the test.

- Once a participant reaches **5** errors, you are to **stop** the test and record **300 seconds** for their time.
- Always mark the participant's errors with a hash mark through the incorrect line.
- If the participant makes an error, make sure that you point out the error (and hash mark it) to the participant, redirect them to the last correct circle and have them continue without stopping the timer.
- These points will be covered again at the Annual Meeting in November during the Site Coordinator Updates and Neurocognitive Training session.
- Future amendments to these protocols will have clarifying language or instructions that re-emphasize these points.
