WF-1802 - Influence of Primary Treatment for Prostate Cancer on Work Experience (PCW)

NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION

PCW (WF-1802) Amendment 4, PVD 06/22/2021, Release Date 09/27/2021

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled *Influence of Primary Treatment for Prostate Cancer on Work Experience (PCW) protocol and related documents have been amended.*

The following changes were made:

- Increased the low-income cutoff point from 200% to 300% of federal poverty guidelines. Because of this modification, we changed our terminology in the protocol. “Low income” is now “lower income.” “Moderate to high income” is now “higher income.”
