NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION

WF-1805CD Amendment 6, PVD 04/01/2024, Release Date 06/13/2024

The WF NCORP Research Base study titled *Implementation and Effectiveness Trial of HN-STAR* has been amended. The amended protocol and related documents were released on **Thursday, June 13, 2024**.

Changes with this amendment include:

- Updated 4.2.5 and 4.2.6 Schedule of Events and Footnotes.
- Added "I am able to work (include work at home)" to the FACTHN(v4) instrument.
- Added "Have you visited your primary care provider in the last year" to the Visits with Other Providers instrument.
- Added new document "Survivor Interview Email Script."
- Updated CTSU language based on 03/26/2024 support logistical template language document.

Regulatory Requirements

NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION

SHINE (WF-2202) Amendment 2, Protocol Version Date 04/30/2024 has been released.

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled <u>Optimizing Psychosocial Intervention</u> for Breast Cancer-related Sexual Morbidity: <u>The Sexual Health and Intimacy</u> <u>Education (SHINE) Trial</u> has been amended. The amended protocol and related documents were released on June 12, 2024.

Changes with this amendment include:

- Removed requirement for enrollment to occur within 7 days of consent.
- Removed options to not respond in two of the PRO documents. (Requirement for an option to not respond was covered in a separate CIRB approved document and remains in the REDCap survey that is viewed by the participant)
- Removed dollar amounts in email notifications for gift cards.
- Added relationship questions to PROMIS SexFS Screener form at 12- and 24week surveys.
- Added relationship question to Communication with Partners PRO form for 12and 24-week surveys.
- Administrative changes to language in protocol.
- Updated CTSU language based on 1/24/2024 and 3/25/2024 support logistical template language documents.
