Hurricane Francine: Potential Delivery Delays September 13, 2024

What is Happening?

Based on current weather forecasts for Hurricane Francine, there is a potential for nationwide delivery delays on Friday, September 13, 2024 (shipments processed on Thursday, September 12, 2024), even in areas not directly affected by weather.

What this means to you:

patient treatment.

There is a potential for carrier delivery delays through the rest of the week due to the storm's impact.

Contact Attempts for Follow up Questionnaires

Onboarding Updates

- Invited sites must return the Study Site Role Log and Tablet Request Form prior to receiving a SOTE letter.
- Once these forms are received and reviewed, your SOTE letter will be sent and then you have <u>45 days from the date of your SOTE letter</u> to enter your community resources into the CONNECT intervention tool.
- Once your community resources are entered into the CONNECT intervention tool, we will review them and contact you to set up an individual site call.
- Your Local Practice Referral Coordinator will be sent an email with a link to the "Start-up Time and Processes" survey. This survey must be completed prior to your first participant accrual.
- Following the site call, we will email you final notification that your site is open to enrollment.
