## (NEW!)WF-1805CD - HN-STAR - Implementation and Effectiveness Trial of HN-STAR

#### **Effective Immediately: Step 1 Participant Enrollment in OPEN is closed.**

We have closed Step 1 enrollment for new participants to the WF-1805CD-HN-STAR study in OPEN. The full enrollment process is not complete until the Step 2 consent and Step 2 enrollment are completed in OPEN. **Only Step 1 of the 2-step process is now closed.** All Step 2 enrollments and DC visits must be completed by April 14, 2025. Any participant who cannot complete their Step 2 enrollment and DC visit by April 14 must be withdrawn from the study.
