Effective Immediately: Step 1 Participant Enrollment in OPEN is closed.

We have closed Step 1 enrollment for new participants to the WF-1805CD-HN-STAR study in OPEN. The full enrollment process is not complete until the Step 2 consent and Step 2 enrollment are completed in OPEN. **Only Step 1 of the 2-step process is now closed.** All Step 2 enrollments and DC visits must be completed by April 14, 2025. Any participant who cannot complete their Step 2 enrollment and DC visit by April 14 must be withdrawn from the study.

The WF-1806, *Myopenia and Mechanisms of Chemotherapy Toxicity in Older Adults with Colorectal Cancer (M&M)* study has been amended. The amended protocol and related documents were released on **Monday, February 24, 2025**. The changes and documents within this amendment must be implemented

within 30 days of this posting.

Changes with this amendment include:

Study Summary (WF2304 - A172401)

The COSMIC Study wants to understand how patients with cancer manage their cancer-related symptoms during treatment.

Why should I be in this study?

- Many patients with cancer have bothersome symptoms that are related to their cancer, and even the medicines they take. Patients often use different ways to help alleviate the symptoms.
- The COSMIC Study wants to understand the potential risks and benefits of the approaches that patients use. Examples include therapies such as acupuncture or meditation, the use of cannabis, dietary supplements, and many others.

For your participation in the COSMIC study, you can receive \$10-\$20 for each monthly survey you complete.

What will I have to do?

- You will be asked to fill out a short survey to see if you are eligible.
- If you are eligible for the study, you will be asked to be in the study for about 13 months and complete the following surveys:
 - Baseline survey
 - 12 monthly surveys (1 per month for 12 months)
- Every survey is done electronically and is confidential. Your responses will not be shared with your medical team.



Taking part in this study is your choice and you may change your mind at any time.

Who will take part in this study?

Adults aged 18 and older who:



- Are currently being treated for a newly diagnosed cancer of the following type: breast cancer, colorectal cancer, melanoma, non-Hodgkin lymphoma, or non-small cell lung cancer.
- Have not started treatment or are in the early stages of treatment.
- Are willing to be in the study for 13 months and complete an electronic survey each month.
- Are receiving medical care from a community oncology clinic.

What is the cost of taking part in this study?

All costs related directly to the study will be paid for by the study. The costs of your regular medical care are unrelated and fall under your existing coverage. The study does not cover your personal internet or cellular data usage charges.
