WF2304-A172401 COSMIC – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Document Updated

Thank you all for joining the WF2304- A172401 COSMIC site call on March 10, 2025. In response to the feedback received, we held discussions with the study team that focused solely on the comments and questions you all provided regarding eligibility. Clarifications in the FAQs, are highlighted as **ADDED** or **UPDATED**. The new version of the FAQs can be found on our Wake Forest NCORP Research Base website https://wakencorp.phs.wakehealth.edu

5. What if a participant is diagnosed with cancer, but they do not receive treatment until 9 months later, if we register them before cycle two, are they still eligible? (UPDATED)

The protocol currently does not define a required timeframe between diagnosis and treatment start. If this is a new cancer that has not been treated before then the patient may be eligible.

26. Recurrent vs. New Primary Cancers. (ADDED)

We will allow enrollment of patients with a new primary cancer if the site's medical team confirms it as a new tumor and not a recurrence. Patients with recurrent cancers of breast, colorectal, melanoma, non-Hodgkin lymphoma, or non-small cell lung cancer are not eligible for this study.

27. Prior Therapies. (ADDED)

Participants who have undergone treatment for a different cancer, may qualify for participation in the COSMIC study.

28. Hormonal Therapy Prior to Chemotherapy or Immune Checkpoint Inhibitor Therapy. (ADDED)

Participants receiving neoadjuvant hormone therapy and/or aromatase inhibitors prior to planned chemo- and/or targeted- therapy are eligible.
