Study Goal: To investigate the impact of a focused education and structured mentorship intervention (COACH-APP) on APP research self-efficacy and integration into the research care team and NCORP activities.

Study Population: Advanced Practice Providers (APPs) employed at NCORP practice providing care to cancer patients potentially eligible for NCORP and/or NCTN trials who are registered as NPIVR but have not served as a site PI for an NCORP trial.

Sample Size: 97 total: 70 APPs randomized 1:1 (35 COACH-APP Intervention/35 Education Control), Subset for Interviews: 10 of 35 COACH-APP APPs, 7 COACH-

APP Mentors, 20 Research Team members (e.g., 10 oncologists and 10 clinical research professionals)

Study Duration: APP study duration is 12 months. Pragmatic practice data collection is through 24 months.

Primary Objective: To compare change in research self-efficacy (RSE) scores (from baseline to 12 months post randomization) between APPs in the COACH-APP intervention compared to the education control.

Strata Closed for 1 Month

Due to recruitment occurring at such a rapid pace, we are going to pause

recruitment in some strata to ensure we maintain a balanced representation of all groups throughout the recruitment phase.

Please continue to screen patients as you normally would. Be aware that with this temporary pause in place, you may see an increased number of screening results come back as "Not Eligible", depending on the potential participant's responses to the self-screening questionnaire. We will send an updated special broadcast email once the restriction is lifted.

A couple reminders!

Please remember to trigger the 12-week surveys in REDCap at 12 weeks post baseline survey completion. Patients and caregivers have +14 days to complete these. All contact attempts should be documented in the Contact Attempt Log. A deviation form must be completed for any surveys completed outside this window.

Friendly reminder that caregivers can be recruited remotely and this is especially helpful when they are not attending a patient's appointment. Further, a caregiver does not need to provide hands-on medical care to be eligible. Care can come in many forms such as providing emotional support, transportation, helping the patient navigate the healthcare system, and more. If a patient is married or partnered, this role often defaults to the spouse/partner. However, caregivers often also include adult children, other family members, or a close "family-like" friend.
