## **NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION**

HYPOGRYPHE (WF-2201) Amendment 7, Protocol Version Date 05/12/2025, Release Date: 06/25/2025.

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled *Hypofractionated Radiotherapy vs Single Fraction Radiosurgery for Brain Metastasis Patients on Immunotherapy (HYPOGRYPHE)* has been amended. The amended protocol and consent were released on June 25, 2025.

The changes and documents within this amendment must be implemented within 30 days of this posting

- Updated visit windows stated within protocol
- Format changes to protocol cover page.

## **NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION**

## COSMIC (WF2304-A172401) Amendment 3, Protocol Version Date 04/01/2025 has been activated.

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled Complementary Options for Symptom Management In Cancer (COSMIC): Assessing Benefits and Harms of Cannabis and Cannabinoid Use Among a Cohort of Cancer Patients Treated in Community Oncology Clinics has been activated. The protocol and related documents were released on July 11, 2025.

The changes and documents within this amendment must be implemented within 30 days of this posting.

## Changes with this amendment include:

- Updated Inclusion Criteria 4.1.1 to provide specific examples of eligible nonsmall lung cancer subtypes and added additional criteria, 4.1.6 which states "Participant must reside in the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam or the US Virgin Islands, officially determined per patient report on the Self-reported Screening Survey."
- 2. Added Inclusion Criteria 4.1.7 "In the treating provider's opinion, the participant should have a life expectancy of >=6 months. Participants in hospice are not eligible" and Exclusion Criteria 4.2.4 "Participants enrolled in hospice."
- 3. Added Exclusion Criteria 4.2.3 stating "Participant received systemic therapy treatment for prior cancer(s) including chemotherapy, immunotherapy, targeted therapy, or hormonal therapy."
- 4. Completion of the Baseline survey before Cycle 1 treatment was removed from the Eligibility Criteria in Section 4.3
- 5. In Protocol, removed references to "additional" measures collected in medical record review for the biospecimen sub-study participants.
- 6. Statement in Section 6.6 "If participants cannabis and/or cannabinoid use status has changed since initial screening, they will be taken off the Optional Biospecimen Sub-Study." was removed.

- 7. Protocol and baseline survey reminders changed to say that the Baseline survey can be completed up to midnight of the day receiving Cycle 2 treatment. Currently, it states that the Baseline survey can be completed up to the start of Cycle 2 treatment.
- On the Main Study + Biospecimen Sub-Study Combined Consent Form, the total amount of blood to be collected at each time point was increased from 1 to 1.5 TBSP / 15mL to 20mL
- 9. The consent form and protocol have been changed to include two email reminders 1 and 3 days after participants have been emailed the link for the Self-Reported Screening survey
- 10. Added the study email to the consent forms with a suggestion that the participant add it to their address book to ensure they receive communications.
- 11. Changed "Questionnaires" to "Surveys" on consent forms. Minor typos and grammatical errors were also corrected on the consent forms.
- 12. Changes have been made to confidential patient-facing REDCap surveys.

  These surveys are not available on CTSU for sites to download. Refer to Summary of Changes for a list of the survey updates.


