- If your site is chosen in the raffle, your site administrator will decide which team member will receive the Travel Award.


Eligibility Requirement:

NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION

COACH-APP (WF-2403) Amendment 2, Protocol Version Date 01/16/2026 has been activated.

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled **Building Capacity within the NCORP Network through an Education and Mentorship Intervention for Advanced Practice Providers (COACH-APP)** has been activated for Amendment 2.

The protocol and consents were released on February 11, 2026.

Changes with this amendment include:

1. Updated practice eligibility inclusion criteria and other sections in the protocol to add language that practices must be enrolled in OPEN within 14 days of receiving the Study Selection Email.
2. Updated APP eligibility inclusion criteria and other sections in the protocol to add language that APPs must be enrolled in OPEN within 14 days of receiving the Study Selection Email.
