

About Eliot: I've been a cancer CRC for a little over a year, previously I spent 7 years working as an ophthalmic photographer. My introduction to research began there, it consisted of a crowded room with an entire wall devoted to massive binders packed full of protocols, my part was a couple pages with complicated imaging protocols. I was relieved when I found that the studies here all live in PDF form and unsurprised that the complexity is still common. Fortunately, I've received excellent support from my team and from Wake Forest as I've taken the lead on WF-1901 (IMPACTS).

Eliot's Reflection on how this study is making a difference: This protocol has

provided opportunities for our patients to participate in research without some of the more intimidating considerations that go into treatment trials. It's a chance to educate our patient community about what we do and that there is more to research than "experimental treatments." Our patients are grateful for the chance to join this trial and receive additional support from our office as they help us create better resources for patients who suffer from cancer-related pain across the globe!
