NEW AMENDMENT ACTIVATION

COSMIC (WF2304-A172401) Amendment 6, Protocol Version Date 03/12/2026 has been activated.

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled Complementary Options for Symptom Management In Cancer (COSMIC): Assessing Benefits and Harms of Cannabis and Cannabinoid Use Among a Cohort of Cancer Patients Treated in Community Oncology Clinics has been activated. The protocol and related documents were released on May 19, 2026.

The changes and documents within this amendment must be implemented within 30 days of this posting.

Changes with this amendment include:

1. Combined cannabis recruitment strata.
2. Combined cannabis policy recruitment strata.
3. Expanded biospecimen sub-study inclusion criteria.
4. Expanded completion window for 6-month surveys from 14 to 30 days.
5. Clarified language regarding the order of administering the consent and the Self Report Screening Survey.
6. Removed “The ***Self-Reported Screening Survey*** has determined that you are eligible to participate in the study” from both consents.
7. Added language to the consents requesting permission to contact participants for future studies. We will not recontact participants already enrolled in the study. Permission to contact for future studies will be applicable for newly enrolled participants. In lieu of recontacting currently enrolled individuals, patients enrolled in this study prior to activation of this amendment (i.e. accrued using a prior consent form which did not contain this proposed addition to the consent) will not be contacted about participation in future studies.
8. Updated NCORP email address throughout the protocol and on funding sheet, removed co-investigator, updated protocol history table.
9. Survey email to participants was updated. With the activation of this amendment, study surveys will be sent from the new email address ncorp@wfusm.edu.

****Please make participants aware that they need to check their junk email for surveys coming from this new address.****

The Spanish-language consent documents that align with the protocol are being translated by the CIRB. A separate broadcast will be distributed when the Spanish-language consents are posted to the CTSU.

The WF NCORP Research Base study entitled **Practical Delivery of Geriatric Assessment in Community Oncology Settings (PGA)** has been activated. The protocol and related documents were released on April 30, 2026.

The changes and documents within this amendment must be implemented within 30 days of this posting.

Changes with this amendment include:

1. Changed “EHR Review” to “EHR PGA Abstraction” in Part 2 Pilot Study Schema, Part 2 – Schedule of Events, throughout the protocol and in the *Part 2 Pilot Study Intro*.
2. Created a NEW PGA Implementation Toolbox which contains various optional items such as flyers, handouts and summary sheets. The Toolbox will be used for Part 2 Pilot Study. Refer to PGA Implementation Toolbox | Appendix 3 for a complete list of the documents.
3. Moved “Data Abstraction” paragraph from Section 9.6.1 to Section 9.6.2 and revised content.
4. Clarified patient eligibility criteria.
5. Updated and renamed the *Part 1 Interview – Patient* document to remove references to the Part 2 Pilot Study patient information.
6. Added social demographic questions to the *Part 2 Patient Survey* document.
7. Updated NCORP protocol version date throughout the protocol, the protocol history table and clarified wording.

All protocol documents along with the recruitment materials were posted to the CTSU website on **4/30/2026**.
