The **Helpful Guide** has been updated to include more instructions for submitting Physical Function Assessment videos for certification purposes. The new version dated 09.08.2026 is available on the WF NCORP RB website on the study specific page.

Study Population: Stage I-III breast cancer patients (18-85 years old) scheduled to receive cytotoxic chemotherapy.

This study is the **first home-based** nationwide primary prevention clinical trial initiating activity and social interaction **prior to administration** of cancer treatment.

It is designed to **reduce exercise intolerance and fatigue** in survivors treated for breast cancer using a low-cost, widely available, and safe intervention.

OPEN CALL FOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Wake Forest NCORP Research Base is soliciting applications for NCORP Community Site representatives for the Cancer Control, Cancer Care Delivery Research (CCDR) Scientific Committees and the Community Engagement Core Committee.

Community site representation on all committees has been expanded. Responsibilities for members will include:

- Attend committee meetings (monthly for the scientific committees and quarterly for the Community Engagement Core)
- Provide feedback about studies early and throughout the study lifecycle to improve feasibility and alignment of studies with community site priorities and provide feedback on implementation challenges
- Provide scientific and feasibility review of new concepts/protocols

- Oversee active studies, including accrual progress
- Periodically review and make recommendations about committee priorities and activities
- Act as a liaison between NCORP community sites/investigators and the Wake Forest NCORP Research Base

We are looking for committee members who bring their expertise within NCORP (PIs or scientific leaders, CRAs, research nursing, and Administrators), their scientific background and populations with whom they engage. Interested individuals should apply using the REDCap link below. The application will include a brief statement (5-10 sentences) on your prior involvement with the Wake Forest NCORP Research Base, experience with cancer control, cancer care delivery research, and/or community engagement research. You will also be asked to upload a CV or biosketch. The initial committee term will be 2 years. **The due date to apply is October 30, 2026.** Selection of committee members will take place in November and committees will begin meetings in January 2027.

Wake Forest NCORP Research Base Clinical Trials Boot Camp - Call for Applications

Deadline: Friday, October 30, 2026, by 11:59pm EST

Monday, February 22 - Wednesday, February 24, 2027
Winston-Salem, NC at Graylyn Conference Center

Brief Overview and Eligibility:

The desired outcome of the 3-day in-person boot camp is a final study concept ready for development into a grant or full NCORP concept proposal to submit to the NCI Symptom Management/Quality of Life (SxQoL) or Cancer Care Delivery Research Steering Committee. Participating mentors have extensive experience

developing NCI concepts and NIH (National Institutes of Health) grants for NCORP studies and will work with each participant to decide if additional pilot data may be needed to support the concept. If so, mentors will assist in developing a plan and budget for pilot activities.

Applicants must be Doctorally trained in any oncology specialty, including medical, surgical, radiation, gynecologic, and pediatric oncology, or faculty from other departments conducting cancer clinical research. Senior fellows may also apply (letter of support from current faculty mentor for fellow applicants strongly encouraged).

The concept must focus on Cancer Control or Cancer Care Delivery Research; oncology treatment trials will not be responsive. Concepts proposing an interventional trial well-aligned with WF NCORP priorities that are feasible to open within the [NCORP community oncology](#) network are strongly encouraged. When appropriate, concepts are encouraged to include biological mechanisms or correlative science where appropriate.

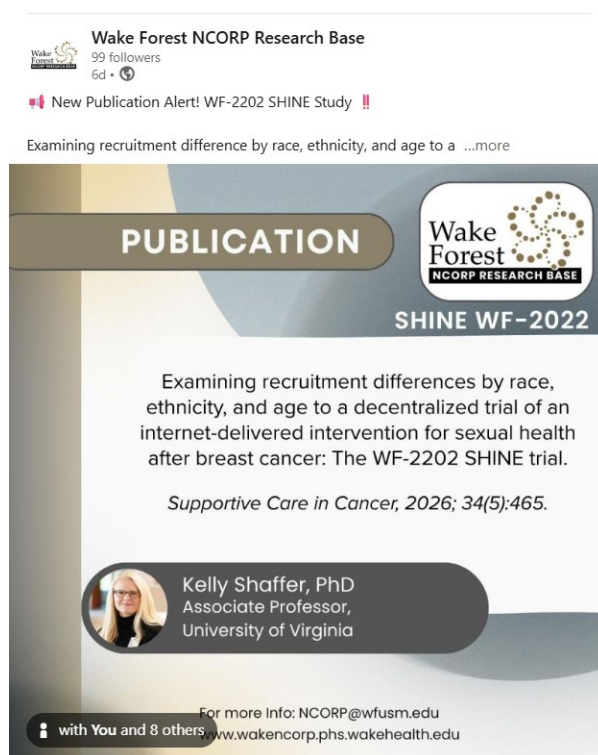
